



How Ebola Spreads

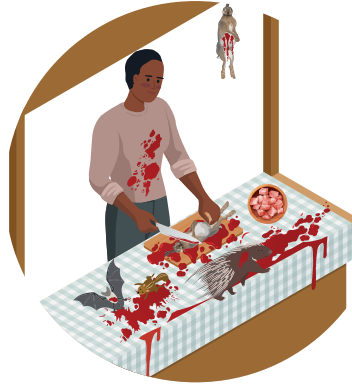


From infected animals

- Ebola spreads to people when they touch sick animals and their fluids, for example:



Touching bats, their urine, droppings, saliva, or eating fruit dropped by infected bats



Touching infected animals



Eating raw or smoked meat from wild animals



From infected people

- People **cannot** spread Ebola before they have symptoms.
- People spread Ebola to other people through bodily fluids when they are sick, such as by:



Touching sweat, saliva, blood, urine, feces, and vomit



Touching sick people



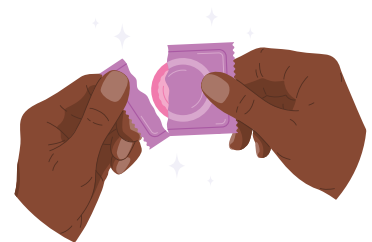
Touching a dead body



Washing a body before burial



Touching a personal item of a sick or dead person
