

DO MORE WITH CSTOR

The *CDC Specimen Test Order and Reporting (CSTOR) Web Portal* is a central online gateway for CDC Infectious Disease Laboratory partners to submit specimens, access test results, and view reports. As CDC's preferred method of specimen submission, CSTOR not only retains the same validations found on the CDC 50.34 Specimen Submission Form and Global File Accessioning Template but also removes manual processes and tracks the status of each submitted specimen. These features accelerate specimen receipt, reduce processing time, and minimize delays. CSTOR is available at no cost for approved primary submitters (e.g., State Public Health Laboratories (SPHLs), federal organizations, and other global submitters), and their approved intermediate submitters (e.g., private healthcare providers, hospitals, universities, veterinary offices, etc.) whose jurisdiction they fall under.
